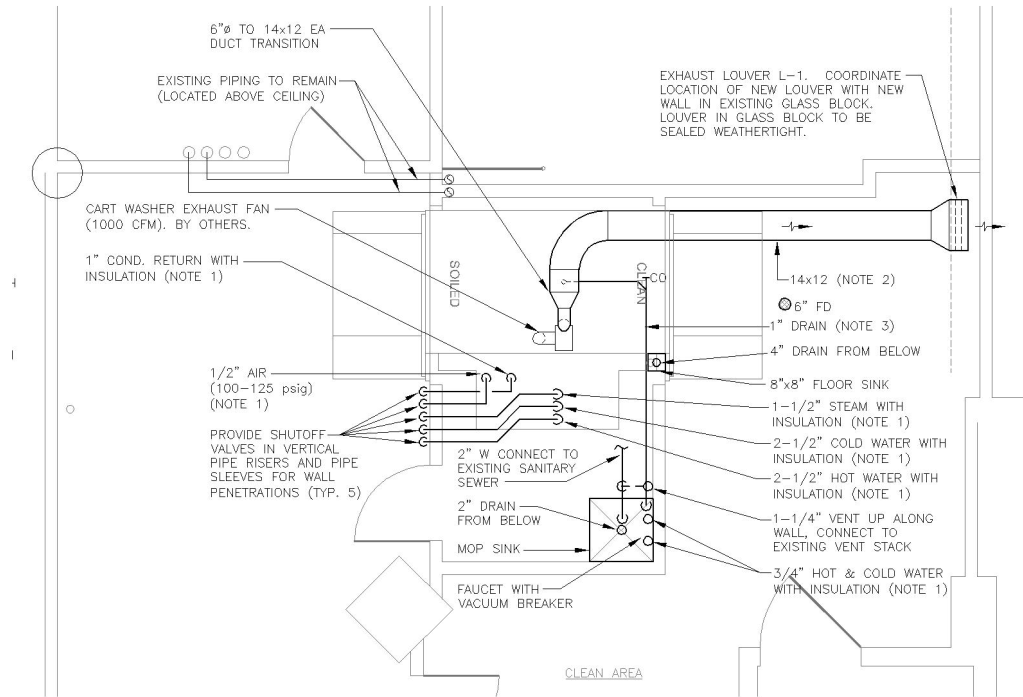




AUTOMATED CART WASHING SYSTEM VETERAN'S ADMINISTRATION MEDICAL CENTER IN BUFFALO

Watts Engineers was commissioned to provide MEP design services in conjunction with an automated cart washing system at the VAMC medical center in Buffalo, New York.

The general scope of work includes selective demolition, trenching and installing piping and drains, assembly of the cart washer unit, connecting mechanical and electrical feeds to the cart washer unit, medium pressure steam and condensate connections, electrical, domestic hot and cold water, and drain connections. Renovation of the surrounding spaces is required to provide adequate staging areas for cart storage pre and post wash. New lighting, sprinklers, floor drains, and ventilation were required for the surrounding areas.

The project was completed in 2004.
