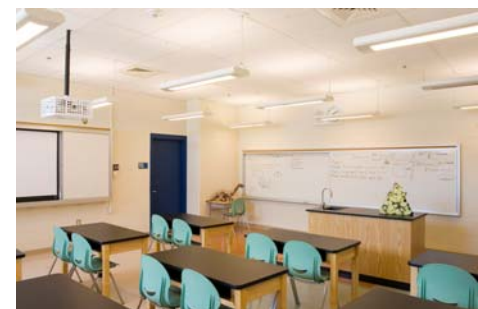

Located on a 7.5 acre site in the South Ward of Newark, NJ, this 115,000 square foot replacement school houses a total population of 550 students. The project is located in the heart of an urban area, and accommodates parking for visitors, faculty and staff, an outdoor amphitheater, playground equipment, two basketball courts, a tennis court, a handball court, and open fields. The playgrounds and courts are used by the community as well as by the school. The project included design, project coordination, construction documentation, and construction administration services. This \$26 million dollar project was completed during the summer of 2004. Watts provided architecture consultation during the construction administration Phase of the project to Hillier Architecture who is the Architect of Record. This project received a design award from the International Masonry Institute – The Golden Trowel Award for the Best in Category – Elementary School Projects (2005).
