School #200 - Bennett High School currently houses approximately 1,000 students from Grades 9-12. This \$28,000,000 project will renovate approximately 100,000 square feet of the existing building in order to create an enhanced learning environment for it's students by modernizing existing classrooms and other amenities. There will also be a new building addition that will add another 18,000 square feet of new classrooms. The school is eighty years old and is considered a historic building eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. The project was formally submitted to the New York State Historic Preservation Office for review prior to bid.
