The reconstruction of All High Stadium consisted of excavating, regrading, and providing a new synthetic athletic field for the newly renovated stadium.

Watts provided the civil engineering including a completely new drainage system for the project. A portion of the monies for the new athletic fields were donated by the National Football League as part of their national athletic development programs for inner city schools. The original stadium building, built in the 1920's is considered a historic structure, and the

design was reviewed by the New York State Historic Preservation Office prior to bid. The stadium in a state of disrepair for years, was completely renovated with new seating, restroom facilities, and a new press box.

Watts provided plumbing design and asbestos/Lead Assessment and Design for the renovation of the stadium. A new running track was provided that encloses the athletic fields with new fencing around the entire site.
