Watts Engineers was selected by the Town of Amherst to design and oversee the construction of a four-lane divided parkway with a landscaped median to provide safe and efficient access to, improve the circulation within, and enhance the visual quality of the John James Audubon Parkway Municipal Complex. Watts Engineers prepared the preliminary design and report, the final design and contract documents, and coordinated the bidding process. Watts Engineers also provided construction support and oversight.

The parkway was completed in two phases during the 2000 and 2001 construction seasons. The work involved a full-depth asphalt pavement section with concrete curbs and drainage system. A traffic signal was designed for the intersection at John James Audubon Parkway, as well as a new internally-lighted entrance sign and internal way-finding signage.

A reconstructed bicycle path, guide railing, and wooden guard railing were included, as were street lighting and landscaping.
